The vineyards of Seville Estate are located in the cooler, southern regions of the Yarra Valley. As a result, our Chardonnay style is crisper, tighter in structure with citrus fruit characters. This is 100% Estate grown Chardonnay.

The 2015 vintage was a great year that produced astounding wines across all varieties with good quantities. Great quality and quantity has not been seen in the Yarra Valley for some years and was gladly welcomed by the industry including the growers and accountants.

Tasting Notes

Bright lifted fruits of melon and grapefruit. Toasted nutty aromas are well integrated with the creaminess from the lees contact. The palate shows fresh melon fruits that evolve into a complex yeast autolysis of spice, nuts and citrus. The mouthfeel shows a fine bead that finishes dry with great acidity adding freshness and purity. This wine is sealed with a crown seal and will age gracefully.

2014 Estate Riesling

Dr Peter G McMahon first planted Seville Estate in 1972 and the 2014 Riesling is the sixth commercially released Riesling from our vineyard. Grafted in 2006 onto 35 year old Chardonnay vines, this Riesling block has fantastic potential.

The 2014 season produced great 'little' wines, 'little' because there wasn't much of it. Poor conditions during spring flowering meant crops were dramatically reduced in Chardonnay and Pinot Noir by up to 60%, later ripening varieties; Riesling, Shiraz and Cabernet fared better losing only 10-20%.

Tasting Notes

A pale straw yellow colour with a clear hue. The wine shows delicate white peach fruits with cinnamon spice and a creamy lime lees complexity. The palate is pure and fine with great balance of acidity, phenolics and fruit weight. Lime sorbet-like acidity gives freshness and crunch. Brioche like lees characters integrate well with perfumed white flowers, melon fruits and sweet spice. The wine is designed for long cellaring with a potential for up to 10 years.

2016 Estate Chardonnay

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The 2016 vintage was a great year that produced astounding wines across all varieties with good quantities. Great quality and quantity has not been seen in the Yarra Valley for some years and was gladly welcomed by the industry including the growers and accountants.

Tasting Notes

The wine is pale yellow with a clear hue. Beautiful aromas of white flowers and stone fruits encased with a flinty lees reduction. The palate is focused and pure with bright melon fruits, sweet spice and a toasted almond oak complexity. The acidity is fine with a lime sorbet like flavour. An elegant and focused style that will age gracefully.

2011 Magnum Chardonnay

The vineyards of Seville Estate are located in the cooler, southern regions of the Yarra Valley. As a result, our Chardonnay style is crisper, tighter in structure with citrus fruit characters.

Tasting Notes

Pale straw yellow colour with a green tinge. Tight melon/white peach with flinty sulphides and almond meal aromas. The melon/white peach flavours continue through the palate with lees complexity that integrates beautifully with the lemon sorbet like acidity. This zesty focused style is designed for aging over the medium term.

2016 Estate Pinot Noir

The 2016 vintage was short and compressed with larger than expected crops, causing havoc and mayhem in the winery during vintage. After the dust had settled and some normality had been restored we were able to look back at what had transpired. What we found surprised us, we had originally thought with the dry season and quick ripening the wines would look concentrated and dense but instead we saw balanced wines with lifted fruits and fine tannins.

Tasting Notes

Beautifully perfumed and lifted showing red berry fruits, spice and hint of sweet nutty oak. The wine is complex showing cherry/strawberry fruits matched with more earthy characters of rhubarb and nutmeg. Whole bunch fermentation adds lift, savouriness and texture to the wine. The tannins are fine and supple while the acidity adds freshness and length to the finish. A great Pinot Noir that (while young) deserves a decanter before showing its true potential.

2015 Estate Shiraz

The 2015 vintage was a great year that produced astounding wines across all varieties with good quantities. Great quality and quantity has not been seen in the Yarra Valley for some years and was gladly welcomed by the industry including the growers and accountants. A mild start to the growing season with October and November producing some beautifully warm Spring days coupled with good rainfall. This lay the foundation for a great start to the season and a kick start to growth in the vineyard. Mild weather conditions with light winds followed through flowering which meant a high percentage of fruit set was achieved.

Tasting Notes

Bright brick red in colour with a pale purple hue. The aromas are complex showing darker fruits, plum and rhubarb. There is a lovely spice thread of cinnamon and nutmeg that softens and adds perfume to the wine. More earthy and savoury on the palate showing great structure from the natural skin tannin and acidity. The whole bunch character sets in the background adding savory depth while balancing the riper berry fruits.
